CASE STUDIES

Past examples of how we have supported farmers include:


- Subsidising alternative plant protection products that are lower risk to water quality
- Working with a farmer in one of our highest risk areas to improve pesticide handling by helping fund a new biobed
- Funding seed for a herbal ley in one of our nitrate vulnerable groundwater catchments
- Part funding a dedicated Farm Cluster
 Officer to help with the establishment and development of a local farm cluster



PRIORITY CATCHMENTS

We currently have 'water friendly' farm support schemes where farmers may be eligible for funding in the following priority catchments:

- Leatherhead groundwater nitrate scheme
- Nonsuch groundwater nitrate scheme
- Oaks Park groundwater nitrate scheme
- Brewer Street groundwater nitrate scheme
- River Eden surface water catchment pesticide and phosphate schemes

PROTECTING WATER QUALITY

WATER FRIENDLY FARMING SUPPORT



SES Water can offer financial support for farmers in our priority areas to help protect drinking water supplies at source.

THIS 2024 SEASON:

Being a small company we are able offer bespoke, case-by-case, support and funding and have the ability to be more flexible than some alternative funding options. Below we outline some of the key initiatives we are looking to support this 2024 season. INTERCEPTION DITCHES/3D BUFFER STRIPS

We are looking for farms to join our pilot study trialling interception ditches/3D buffer strips. We would like to improve the functionality of existing buffer strips, working with farmers to add features such as interception ditches and increasing the diversity of plant species in the strips to better trap sediment, pesticides and nutrients and prevent them being washed into watercourses.





CROP MANAGEMENT

We can support farms looking to use cover crops, intercropping, companion crops and herbal leys. These practices have been shown to improve soil health and can help protect water quality.

PASTURE FOR LIFE MEMBERSHIP

We are currently offering free Pasture for Life (PfL) membership for livestock/mixed farms not already eligible through the FiPL funded Pasture Profits in Protected Landscapes programme. There is no obligation for farms to work towards PfL certification, however for those interested in pursuing this we would be happy to discuss additional support needed.

1-2-1 ADVICE VISITS

We offer farm visits with our partners Catchment Sensitive Farming (CSF), offering 'water friendly farming' advice along with help signposting to Rural Payments Agency funding (and potential for SES Water funding on a case-by-case basis where gaps exist). Funding for follow-on expert advice visits from independent third parties may also be available in priority areas. These visits are free and impartial.

FARM CLUSTER SUPPORT

We are keen to offer support to local farm clusters within our priority catchments and work together to help achieve shared aims across the catchment.

VOLUNTARY WORK

SES Water regularly run a number of corporate 'give-a-days' to help with local environmental projects and give back to local communities. If you have projects taking place on your farm, we can help out.
